

ORDINANCE NO. 2009-006

AN ORDINANCE ALLOCATING INSTALLMENT PAYMENTS ON FINES AND COSTS 50% TO FINES AND 50% TO COURT COSTS.

WHEREAS, court-ordered fines and costs are often paid in installment payments creating uncertainty as to allocation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Tyronza, Arkansas, as follows:

SECTION 1. After the effective date of this ordinance and pursuant to A.C.A. § 16-10-209, all installment payments of court ordered fines and costs in the Tyronza District Court shall be allocated 50% to court costs and 50% to fines until either costs or fines are fully paid, then remaining payments shall be applied to any amount due.

SECTION 2. The efficient operation of the court system is essential to the administration of justice, and this ordinance being necessary for preservation of the public peace, health and safety, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
